The second his one-time friend, and now a member of the Communist corp, Manolo Torres. As you watch, make point-form notes on the events in the two men's lives, from childhood until the end. It need not be greatly detailed, but tracks their experiences, and provides evidence of careful watching of the film.

Scoring Guide

(ie: How to get the score you want):

- Evidence that you watched the film (maybe while surfing Instagram or doing something else) and there's the broad strokes, but a real lack of specifics.
(65-75% max)
- Clear evidence you've watched the film and paid attention to it. Points have some of the more subtle events and things that happen, focussing not just on the broad strokes, but personal and inter-personal conflicts too. No summary or thoughts of your own at the end.
(76-85% max)
- The same as the one above, but also a bit of a summary of your thoughts on the conflict itself, and your feelings while watching the film and seeing the ending.
(86-100%)
