

## LAW 12 – ALTERNATE – UNIT 8

Read the Articles linked, and watch the rest of the video. We got about 28 minutes in during class (likely).

- 1) List things you learned as a result of reading/watch this material, that surprised or shocked you.
- 2) Answer the following: Should children be put in prison? Why/Why Not?
- 3) Answer the following as well: What should be done differently with child offenders (if anything)?

Submit via MyEd prior to the test period, as a word document. If it's not in by then, you write the unit test. There are caps on your score, depending on how close to the test date you submit it.

**The key to an exceptional response is putting some of yourself in it. I want to know more than the fact that you've read/watched things, but that you connected with it, made associations, had genuine surprise/shock/anger/empathy etc. I want to know what you FELT and if it changed how you THINK.**

### Scoring Guide

(ie: How to get the score you want):

- Evidence that you went through the content and paid attention. There's a list of 5-10 things you are responding to in some way. There may be some linkages among content, but not much. Length of response is 1-1.5 pages or so. There's some of you in there, but not in depth yet. (60-70% max)
- Evidence that you went through the content and paid close attention. There's a list of 8-10+ things you are responding to, and that's presented in a good 2-3 pages here at least. Some personal reflection and reaction is clearly in here as well, and your own opinion and commentary can be seen. (71-85% max)
- The same as the one above, but there's definite evidence in the form of quotes or phrases used, as you make your linkages and points. There's a good 3-4 pages of content here, and I can see your own thought processes and awareness in it. Perhaps there is even a little research sprinkled in, backing up your conclusions and commentary. (86-100%)
